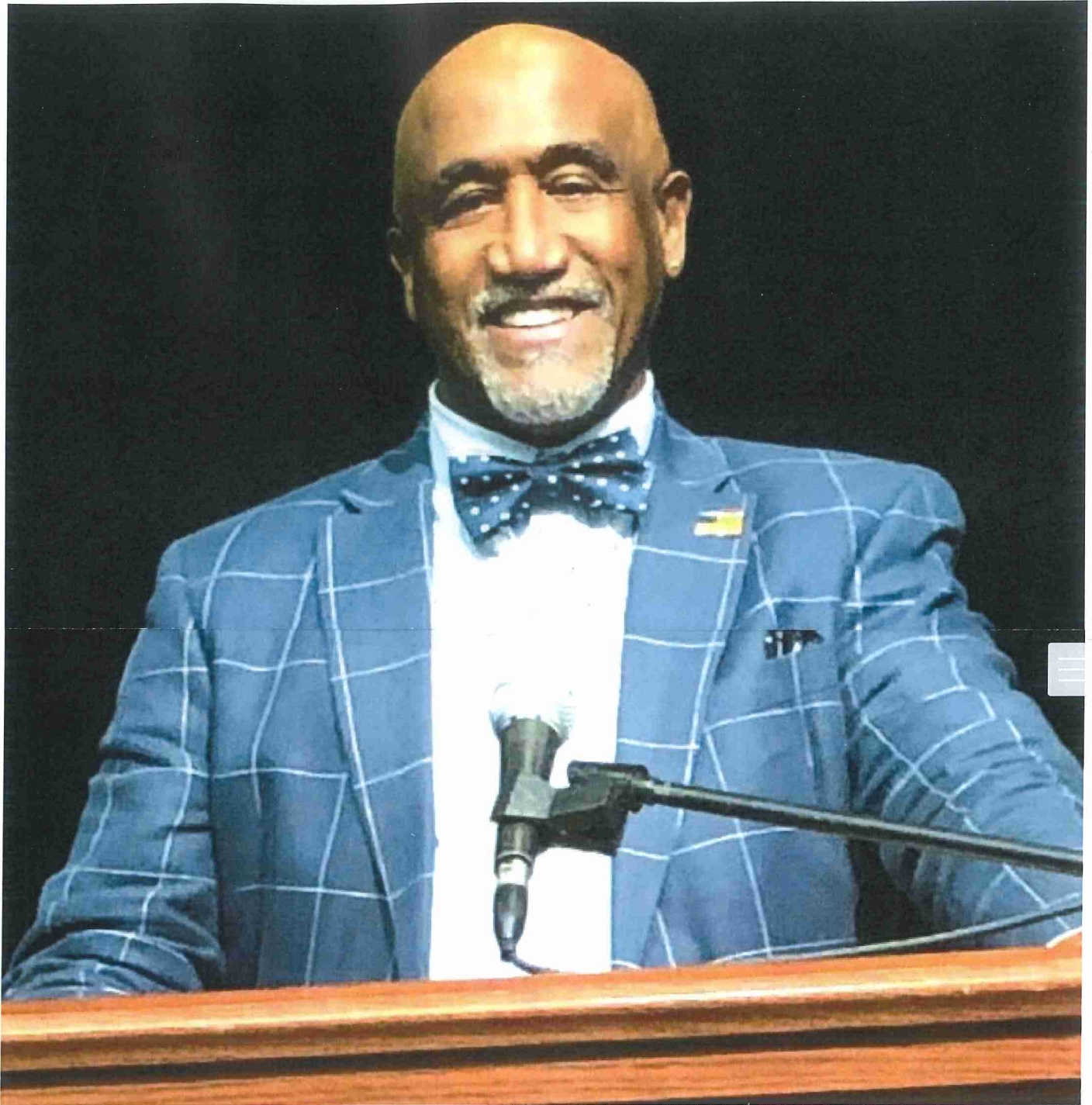


Jones For Lieutenant Governor of PA
